



BRANDGUARDIAN Christmas calendar: Get Christmassy by making your own Christmas calendar!

We have designed the templates for you in a trendy black and white look. Print out on thicker paper (min. 150g/m2), cut out and fold. You do not have to glue anything.

The material you need:

- 24 sheets of paper min. 150g/m2 (can also be colored)
- Ink jet or laser printer
- Paper scissors (or cutter) for cutting out
- optional: one ruler and one bone folder
- optional: rope, parcel string or tape to hang up
- optional: branches, LED chain, small candles to decorate as desired


Here are a few ideas for filling:

- Favourite chocolate / sweets
- Vouchers (if necessary, self-made e.g. "Voucher for a foot massage")
- 24 compliments or poems
- Bath salts or other small cosmetic products
- 24 wishes
- Puzzle (simply distribute puzzle pieces on the individual days. e.g. with a nice message)

Before you start, turn on some Christmas music, have a glass of Mulled wine, relax and enjoy the mood.



Instruction



Print out the 24 pages of the template and cut out all boxes with the paper scissors. Cut the continuous lines.

Place the template on the table with the pattern facing down. Now fold the box along the dotted lines e.g. over the edge of the table. Use a ruler and a bone folder to make it work especially well.

Now fold the boxes together by first folding the longest side (with the number on the lid) with the shortest one and then securing it with the other two sides.




Now the box is ready! To hang the boxes on a fir tree or a branch, you can simply pull a thread under the lid.


Let your imagination run free and decorate the Christmas calendar with punched out stars, snowflakes or LED lights.


